LATE REGISTRATION FEE: If you register after May 21, there will be a \$1.00 fee added to each activity/class you enroll in. NO REGISTRATION FOR CLASSES WILL BE ALLOWED AFTER JUNE 1 – please note these new policies. RETURNED CHECKS: A \$25.00 fee will be charged for any checks that are returned for insufficient funds.
