# Water/Sewer

- Replaced a couple of tires on the water truck and trailer.
- Cardinal Hill water main is still having trouble passing testing. Met. With Mr. Kuhn, MEC Engineer, and Joyner Construction and formulated a plan that is now underway.
- "Mavis Sewer" has been jetted and vac'd.
- South Lift Station has had the impellers replaced on both pumps due to wear from use and age.
- Water event on Sattley on 9/26/2020.
- Issue with meter reading this month. It caused quite a few re-reads. Issue has been resolved.
- Fire hydrants have been replaced at Water Tower, Willow Drive, and John Street. Removed retired hydrant on East Main.
- Final read discrepancy. It was determined that the splice made when the transmitter was updated had an intermittent connection thereby not registering all gallons of water used. The difference was approximately 1 million gallons over many years. This transmitter and register have been updated to new cellular read.

• Flushed sewer main on Sattley. Resident complained of sewer smell in their basement.

#### **Streets**

- The Woodlands streetlight that was knocked over last winter is still under repair. The company that makes the parts has retired that line of products and they are seeking ways to make it work for us.
- Replaced a driveway culvert on Circle Drive that was not wide enough once ditch work was done.
- Helped Rochester Township with tar and chip on their roads.
- Long section of sidewalk on South Walnut is on agenda for 10/13/2020.
- Helping Spaulding with road issues.
- North Walnut drainage project is going to be crossing North Walnut tomorrow, 10/14/2020.
- A resident from the Meadows has approached up on a retention pond issue in the rear of their property. This is being looked into.
- Summer banner-style flags are down, and fall banner flags are up.

# Parks/Property

- Helped set up for movie in the park.
- Repaired the dugout on field 3.
- Met to discuss new plans for batting area near field 1.
- "Walk Across" bridge at the Play Project needed some repair. It took 4 guys for 10 minutes of work.

- Update on Census 2020 Rochester was 1<sup>st</sup> place in Sangamon County with the highest self-response rate with 87.9% of houses responding and 6<sup>th</sup> in the State of Illinois. Gordon Wayman the Partnership Specialist for the US Department of Commerce for the 2020 Census can to the Village to present "Congratulations" certificate.
- Village employee Health, Dental and Vision insurance has historically been due at three different times in the calendar year. This year we have taken steps to move them all to come due on January 1, 2021. We will be receiving the renewal packages soon to review and share with the two employee unions that will begin January 1, 2021. We are not expecting there to be large monetary changes this year with the health plan and no changes with the dental and vision plans.
