- Vendors may set up their tents/trailers the night before the event or may set-up as early as 7:30am on Saturday. Please unload as quickly as possibly then move your vehicles to the parking area behind the tree line.
- There will be a sign on a post at your designated vendor space indicating how many spaces your reserved. Vendors who do not set up in the correct location, will be asked to move. Please contact the Festival Coordinator if you need clarification regarding your location.
- Vendors are responsible for providing their own tents, tables, chairs and power cords.
- Vendors are responsible for cleaning up their areas after the festival ends.
- You must list ALL individuals on the contract that will be with you in your space, prior to the event.
- The Fall Festival will not be canceled due to rain but may be canceled in the event lightning occurs.
- The Village of Rochester is not liable for any damage or theft.
- No refunds.
